MOORE INTERNS RECEIVE SENATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Boston – Senator Michael O. Moore (D-Millbury) announced today that two interns in his office, both Millbury residents, have been awarded the Arthur R. Lambert Memorial Scholarship. Lindsey Beauregard, a student at Stonehill College, and Nicole Lillie, a student at Assumption College, were among seven recipients of the honor, which is named for the late Mr. Lambert, a former staff member to the Massachusetts Senate.

“It came as no surprise to me that Lindsey and Nicole won this scholarship,” said Sen. Moore. “Both have been an invaluable addition to my office, and both are a credit to young people in our area. I am sure that they will find success in all of their future endeavors.”

Beauregard, a 2009 graduate of Millbury High School, is pursuing a degree in International Studies at Stonehill. Lillie, who graduated from Notre Dame Academy in Worcester in 2008, is studying Psychology at Assumption.

To be awarded the scholarship, applicants were required to submit essays addressing their views regarding what “public service” means to them, and provide examples of their involvement in civic life. Winners were selected by family members of the late Mr. Lambert.

Arthur R. Lambert began his career as an aide to former Representative Robert Durand in 1987. He eventually became Chief of Staff to Durand, who was then serving in the State Senate, and became directly involved in all aspects of state government, including legislative work and day-to-day office matters. When Sen. Durand was appointed by Governor Paul Cellucci in 1997 to become Secretary of Environmental Affairs, Arthur ran for the seat, but was defeated in the Democratic Primary. After the election, Arthur was approached by Senate President Thomas Birmingham to work as an aide in his office. He was honored and readily accepted this position. Lambert was killed in an automobile accident in 2000.
