LEGISLATION PASSED GRANTING TWO ADDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSES TO MILLBURY

Boston – Senator Michael O. Moore (D-Millbury) and Representative Paul K. Frost (R-Auburn) announced that the House and Senate recently passed legislation authorizing two additional liquor licenses for the Town of Millbury. Both licenses are for use at The Shoppes at Blackstone Valley. The bill was filed by Rep. Frost and Sen. Moore. The Millbury Town Meeting, with support of the selectmen, voted in favor of petitioning the state legislature for these two additional liquor licenses to further support the Shoppes.

“This is good news for Millbury's economy,” said Sen. Moore. “These licenses will enable new businesses to thrive and attract customers in Millbury, which will in turn attract customers to the shops and businesses in the area.”

Rep. Frost commented, “These licenses will help the Shoppes at the Blackstone Valley attract more restaurant tenants. This will provide more economic activity in Millbury, create local jobs and provide more dining and convenient choices for the public.”

The legislation will now go before the Governor for signage.
