LEGISLATURE PASSES BILL GRANTING MILLBURY ADDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSE

Boston – Senator Michael O. Moore (D-Millbury) announced today that Senate Bill 1961, which would grant the Town of Millbury an additional liquor license, has been enacted and sent to Governor Patrick for his signature.

“As new businesses seek to open up shop in Millbury, it is important that we enable the town to keep up with demand,” said Sen. Moore. “At a time when the economy continues to recover at a slow pace, I am pleased that there is such interest in additional business development in Millbury.”

The home rule petition will allow the Town to issue one additional liquor license for the sale of alcoholic beverages to be drunk off the premises to enhance economic development at The Shoppes at Blackstone Valley.
