MOORE SWORN IN FOR SECOND TERM IN SENATE

Boston – Senator Michael O. Moore (D-Millbury) was officially sworn in for his second term in the Massachusetts Senate yesterday, in a ceremony taking place in the Senate Chamber at the State House. Sen. Moore will continue to represent the Second Worcester District, which includes Auburn, Grafton, Leicester, Millbury, Shrewsbury, Upton, and Wards 5-8 in the City of Worcester.

“I am honored and excited to begin my second term in the Senate,” said Sen. Moore. “We have made a lot of progress over the course of my first term, on important issues such as ethics, pension, and transportation reform. However, there is still much work to be done to continue moving Massachusetts in the right direction. I look forward to the challenging two years ahead.”

Sen. Moore was first elected to the Senate in 2008, and has served since January 2009. During his first term, the Senator Chaired the Committee on Community Development and Small Business. In that capacity, he oversaw major oversight hearings into abuses and inefficiency by the Division of Unemployment Assistance that had been adversely affecting small businesses. Prior to his election, he served as a Selectman in the Town of Millbury from 2001 to 2008. He is married to Ellyn Lazar-Moore, an Assistant District Attorney in Worcester County. They have two children, ages 9 and 6.
