**MOORE, CHANDLER ANNOUNCE TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT HEARING TO
BE HELD IN WORCESTER**

Senator Michael O. Moore (D-Millbury) and Senator Harriette L. Chandler (D-Worcester) have announced that the Legislature's Joint Committee on Transportation will hold an Oversight Hearing in Worcester. The hearing will take place at the Worcester Public Library, 3 Salem Square, Worcester, at 10:30AM on Wednesday, July 20, 2011, relative to Worcester and Central Massachusetts transportation issues. This hearing will be the first of the previously announced state-wide Joint Committee on Transportation Oversight Hearings.

The Oversight Hearing will enable the members of the Joint Committee on Transportation and Representatives and Senators from the Worcester area to receive information on MassDOT transportation projects in Worcester, as well as be briefed on the Worcester Airport, current activity at Union Station and the Commuter Rail in Worcester, the Worcester Regional Transit Authority, and other relevant issues. There will also be an opportunity for Representatives and Senators to ask questions and voice any opinions or concerns directly to MassDOT Secretary Jeffrey Mullan, as well as MassDOT Administrators and other transportation experts.

The Oversight Hearing is open to the general public to attend, but no public testimony will be heard.

The Oversight Hearing will be accompanied by a tour of the Worcester Airport, Route 146, the WRTA Grove Street facility, and other Worcester transportation projects for members of the Joint Committee on Transportation and legislative members of the Worcester Delegation.
