**MOORE, CENTRAL MASS LEGISLATORS HOST TOWN HALL FORUM ON
ECONOMY, BUDGET**

WORCESTER –Senator Michael O. Moore (D-Millbury), Senator Harriette L. Chandler (D-Worcester), and legislators from throughout Central Massachusetts will host their second annual Town Hall-style community forum with Michael Widmer, President of the Massachusetts Taxpayers Foundation on **Wednesday, March 31st at 6:30 p.m. at Worcester Technical High School**. The evening will feature a discussion of the state of the economy and its impact upon state and local budgets.

The Massachusetts Taxpayers Foundation is a non-partisan public policy organization that specializes in analyzing state and local fiscal, economic and tax policies.
